

Important Health Notice

THE SCHOOL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET AND SUBMITTED TO YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST ENTRY DAY OF SCHOOL. *No enrollment forms will be collected / processed without proper health requirements.*

The Hawaii State Administrative Rules require that all new students to any public or private school in the State of Hawaii must have and submit the following: (See attached brochure "Important Notice to Parents-School Health Requirements")

1. A negative Tuberculosis clearance (TB skin test- PPD, Mantoux, or a chest x-ray) done within one year of initial entry. PPD must show date given, date read, results (mm reading) and who administered it (must be done within the United States.)
2. A physical examination that was done within one year of initial school entry or a signed statement or appointment card from your child's doctor.
3. A current and up-to-date immunization record (including documentation of varicella vaccination or physician's documentation / confirmation of chicken pox).

*If your child attended preschool in Hawaii, documentation of the previous Tuberculosis clearance and physical examination will be accepted.

WITHOUT THE COMPLETED HEALTH REQUIREMENTS.**
